The call is addressed to everyone: lay people as well are personally called by the Lord, from whom they receive a mission on behalf of the Church and the world." (Christifides Laici 1989)
- Pope Benedict "The lay faithful must no longer be viewed as collaborators of the clergy but as 'co-responsible' for the Church's being and action" (6th Assembly of the International Catholic Action Forum August 2012)
- Pope Francis, as the Bishop of the Diocese of Rome, in January 2023 has himself asked that each parish in his diocese form a Parish Pastoral Council as an organ of "ecclesial communion, community discernment and co-responsibility to which the bishop must listen."
