## **WORLD GRANDPARENT'S DAY SUNDAY 23RD JULY**

The Vatican has granted a Plenary Indulgence for grandparents, the elderly, and all faithful who participate in the solemn celebration presided over by the Pope in St. Peter's Basilica, as well as to all those who attend Mass in various parts of the world on the 23rd July. The theme for this day is "His mercy is from age to age" (Lk 1:50). The indulgence is subject to the usual conditions of sacramental Confession, reception of the Eucharist, and prayer for the intentions of the Holy Father. A plenary indulgence offers remission of the temporal punishment due to sins already forgiven, which can be applied to oneself or to the souls in Purgatory.
