Entrance Antiphon: Give me justice, O God, and plead my cause against a nation that is faithless. From the deceitful and cunning rescue me, for you, O God, are my strength.

Responsorial Psalm: A pure heart create for me, O God.

Communion Antiphon: *Amen, Amen I say to you: Unless a grain of wheat falls to the ground and dies, it remains a single grain. But if it dies, it bears much fruit.*

Saturday morning prayer starts at 8:45am followed by the rosary and then Mass. Children's Liturgy dates for 2024: 21st April, 12th May, 9th June and 7th July.

Next Week is Palm Sunday. All Masses will commence in the narthex for the commemoration of the Lord's entrance into Jerusalem.

The weekly donor boxes of envelopes for the next tax year will be distributed after all masses over this and the next weekend, as well as the smaller packs of envelopes for second collections for all parishioners that currently donate by a Standing Order.

We simply need your name and address and a record of your donations by either using a monthly standing order, or by placing your cash/cheque donations in a pre-printed envelope each week. PILGRIMAGE TO SPAIN & FATIMA LED BY FR. PAUL - 20TH TO 26TH MAY 2024 Join this wonderful seven day pilgrimage to Spain and Fatima led by Fr. Paul.

4 nights half board accommodation in Spain - Walking in the footsteps of Saint Teresa of Avila, Visiting Salamanca and Segovia, the Monastery of Saint John of the Cross and Vallodolid.

2 nights full board accommodation in Fatima - Visiting the Sanctuary in Fatima, the Rosary Basilica, the Chapel of Apparitions and the Holy Trinity Basilica. Attending the Rosary candlelight procession and the International Mass on Sunday.
