# PALM SUNDAY OF THE PASSION OF THE LORD - 24TH MARCH 2024

(Psalter Week 2)

Entrance Antiphon: Hosanna to the Son of David; blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord, the King of Israel. Hosanna in the highest.

Responsorial Psalm: My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?

Communion Antiphon: Father, if this chalice cannot pass without my drinking it, your will be done.

The Sacrament of Penance is available on Saturday mornings from 11am until the final confession and before and after Mass on Saturday evening and by prior arrangement.

As we enter into this most holy of weeks in our liturgical calendar we are invited into a personal journey with the Lord who always walks beside us. Beginning with Palm Sunday, we are invited to stand with the crowd in Jerusalem to chant 'Hosanna to the Son of David! Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord!' On Maundy Thursday let us take our place at table with Our Lord at the Last Supper before proceeding to stand at the foot of the cross on Good Friday. As silence descends on Good Friday evening let us enter into the quiet anticipation of the Resurrection and the beginning of our Salvation on Easter Sunday. I pray we will all enter into the spirit of Holy Week with open hearts and allow Our Lord to bestow his grace and blessings on us all this Easter.

# PILGRIMAGE TO SPAIN & FATIMA LED BY FR. PAUL - 20TH TO 26TH MAY 2024
