REPAIRS TO CHURCH ROOF COPING STONES

For many years joints in the roof coping stones have allowed rainwater to soak into brickwork below which at present is most noticeable on the wall at high level above where the choir usually assemble. Previously similar repairs have been undertaken to other areas of the church roof. To rectify this problem a scaffold will be erected on Monday 1st – 2nd July to allow repairs to take place and there will be no access to the church car park. Similarly when the scaffolding is removed the same restrictions will apply. Once the scaffolding is in place access will be reinstated however the width of vehicular access will be reduced to a minimum of 2.2 metres so please drive carefully and be aware of people walking along this access road. The work is expected to take no more than 2 weeks. Regular Mass services will continue as usual.

CHURCH FLOORING REFURBISHMENT

The Church will be closed from 1pm on Sunday 21st July and will re-open at 5.30pm on Saturday 27th July to undertake the refurbishment of the Church timber flooring. The regular weekday Mass will be celebrated in the Hall Upper Room during this week.
