28th February 2021. – Second Sunday of Lent. Year B.

Celebrating the Word-by Fr. Fernando Armellini.

“The story of the transfiguration is right at the centre of Mark’s gospel. The disciples from the very beginning had begun asking themselves who Jesus was and at a certain point had begun to think that he was the Messiah.

Their ideas were however are still very confused. Like the rest of the people they expected a glorious messiah, a rich and a powerful ruler, capable of restoring the kingdom of God on earth. We see Peter who suggests they make three shelters; as he is convinced that the Kingdom of God has come and it is no longer necessary to die.

The main message of this passage is that we have to undergo death in order to restore the kingdom. This is why Jesus allows his disciples to glimpse his transfiguration. There are no short-cuts regarding the entrance to the kingdom of God as Peter would like.

All Jesus disciples must follow him along the path he trod. It was only little by little that the disciples discovered the true identity of the Messiah. The resurrection will ultimately throw light on the words and deeds of the Master, and it will be only after Easter that Jesus is fully revealed as the Messiah.

We too may live with false expectations; flatter ourselves that we go from this world to the world of glory easily or without dying. The only path is the path of Christ; it is the way of the cross that leads to resurrection.”
