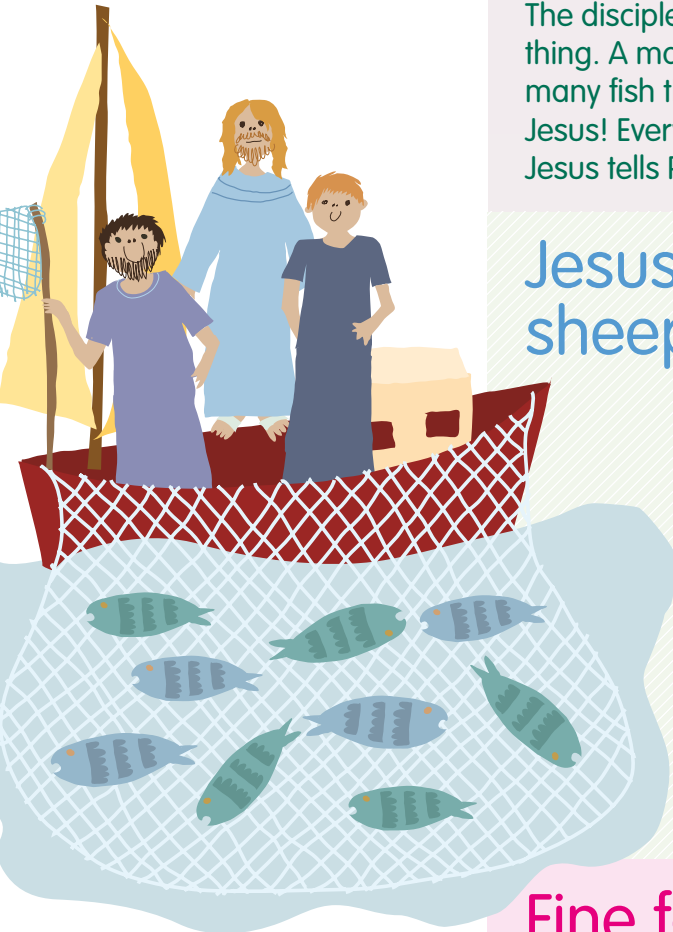

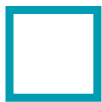

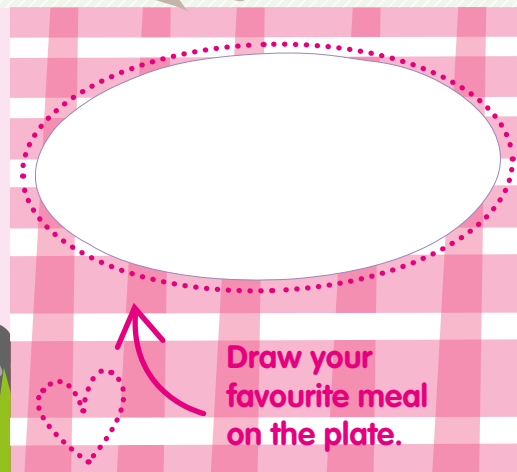
How many fish?

Jesus cooked fish for the disciples.



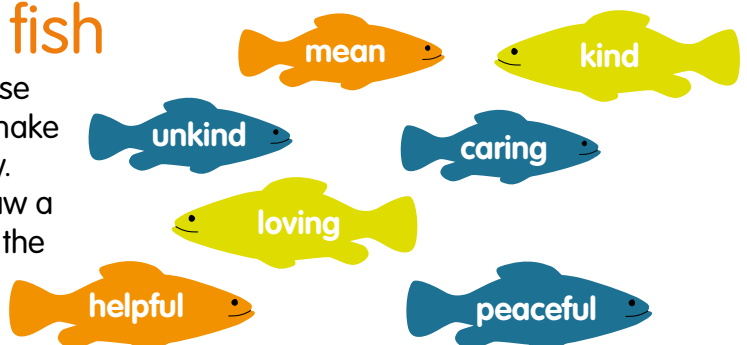

Would you like to play with my car for a bit?

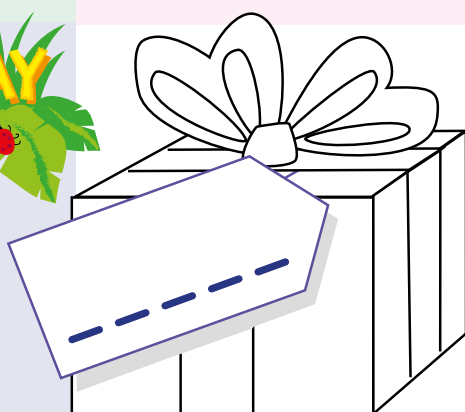

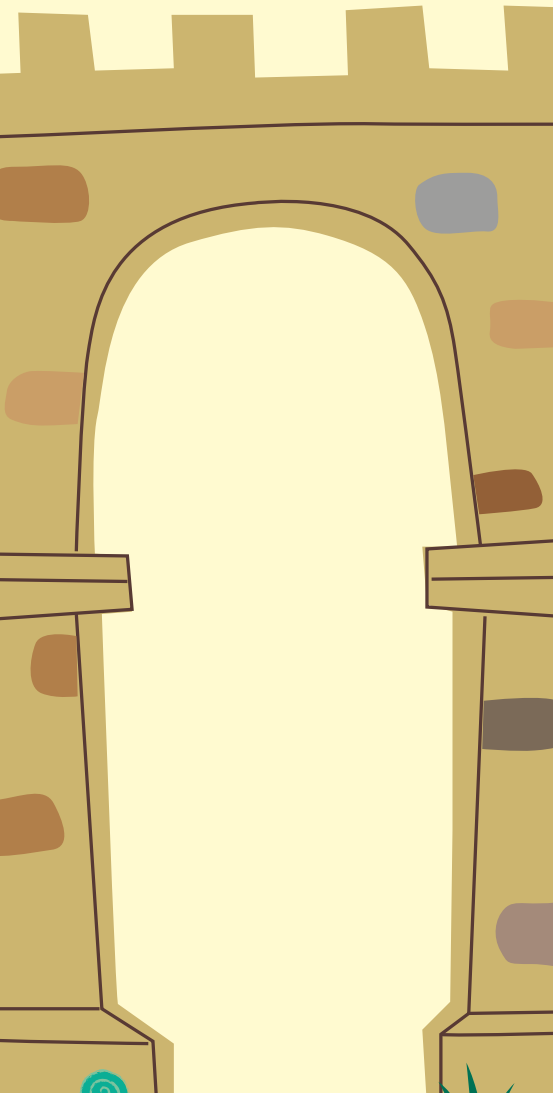

Joyful disciples

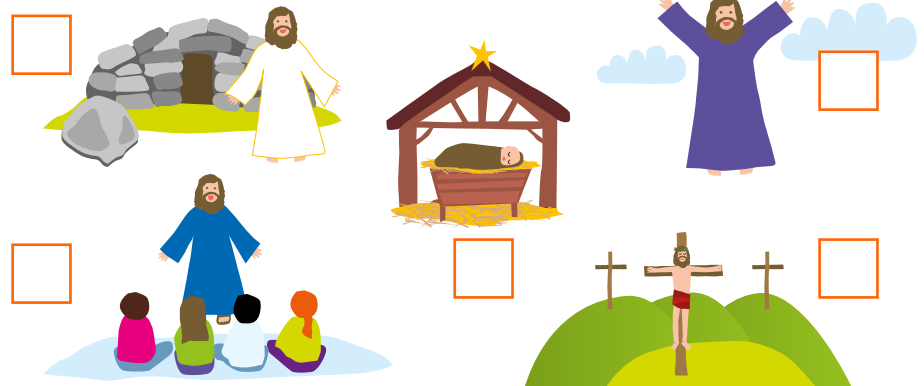
Draw some disciples happily praising God in the Temple.

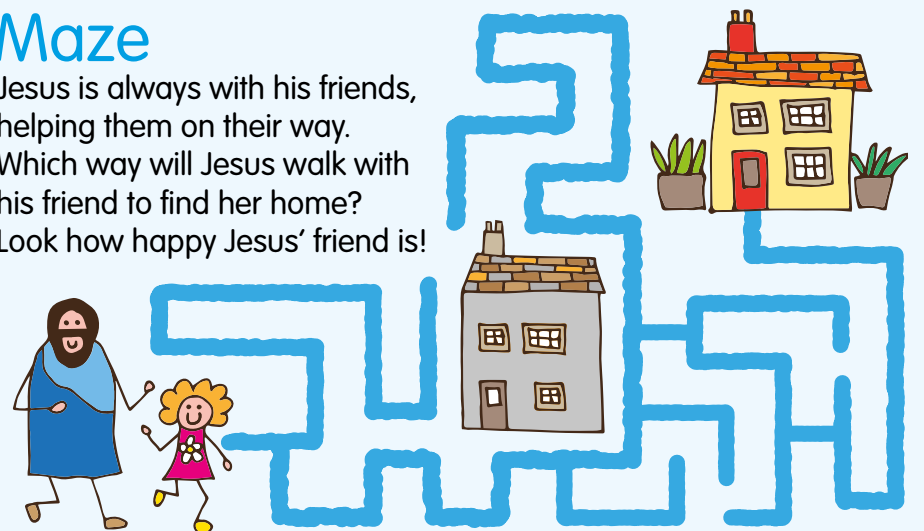
The life of Jesus
