#### PARISH CAR PARK

Following a couple of disturbing incidents recently where Parish staff were threatened and intimidated by a group of young men using the Parish car park for illicit purposes, a report from the Met Police has recommended that we review security measures around the Church premises, including installation of CCTV cameras around the car park. The proposal has been accepted by the Parish Council and installation work will commence shortly and should not cause inconvenience to members of our Community. Please use extra care and patience during the installation phase which should not take more than a couple of days. The Parish Council has been asked to review usage of the car park, which is also used by tradesmen, parish visitors and users of the parish hall, but at this stage it is not considered likely that any changes will be necessary for use by members of the Parish- but please continue to use the car park responsibly and with consideration for others.
