# WELCOMERS - We need you!

### FIRST FRIDAY LUNCH - Safety Talk

Last Friday, we were pleased to welcome Karen, our Faith Police Liaison Officer, to our First Friday lunch. Karen gave an insightful talk to our parishioners about staying safe and knowing what to do in an emergency. One important tip Karen shared is about a free app called *What3Words*. This app helps the emergency services locate you if you need to call 999. Every place has its own unique three words. If you open the app, it will show you the three words for where you are standing. If you are unsure of how to describe your exact location, or if you cannot give a clear address or landmark, you can simply share those three words with the operator. They will then know precisely where to find you.
